God Communicates His Peace

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. –Philippians 4:6–7

God communicates His direction for our lives through prayer, and He also communicates His peace to us through prayer. We see an example of this in the life of the apostle Paul. If anybody had reason not to be at peace, it was Paul when he wrote his letter to the Philippian Christians. At that time, the church in Philippi was being attacked by false teachers from without and torn apart by division from within. Not only that, but Paul was under house arrest in Rome. He was awaiting the verdict in his two-year trial—was he going to live or die? He didn't know from one moment to the next what his future would hold.

Paul had any number of things he could've chosen to worry about. But look at what he wrote in Philippians 4:6: "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God." I like this paraphrase of the verse: "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything" (TLB).

Let me give you a suggestion I once heard from my friend David Jeremiah. Take a sheet of paper and write at the top "My Worry List." Then write down everything you're worried about. Then take another sheet of paper and title it "My Prayer List." Now, one by one, scratch out the items on your worry list and place them on your prayer list. And when you spend time with God, pray over those things.

What happens when you turn your worries into prayer requests? Look at verse 7: "The peace of God, which surpasses all comprehension, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." Paul was saying, "If you pray about everything instead of worrying about everything, then in some inexplicable way, the peace of God will flood your heart."

David Jeremiah said in his years as a pastor, he has discovered that people whose worry list is full and running over usually have an empty prayer list. And the opposite is true as well: those who have a full prayer list usually have an empty worry list. God communicates His peace to us when we pray.

Greetings CMA family,

Sometimes as Christians we forget that we're fighting a spiritual battle. A lot of the things that we're facing in life have a spiritual element to them.

Ephesians 6:12 reminds us, *"For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and against evil spirits in the heavenly places"* (NLT).

And when David went out to face the giant Goliath in battle, he said, "Everyone assembled here will know that the Lord rescues his people, but not with sword and spear. This is the Lord's battle, and he will give you to us!" 1 Samuel 17:47 NLT.

In a spiritual battle, we must use spiritual weapons. The Bible tells us, "We are human, but we don't wage war as humans do. We use God's mighty weapons, not worldly weapons, to knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments" (2 Corinthians 10:3-4 NLT).

What are spiritual weapons? Prayer is one of them. Have you ever noticed how big your problems can seem when you haven't prayed? Worry overtakes you. It's like a force all on its own. You can worry yourself into a frenzy.

Here's what the Bible says about worry: "Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:6-7 NLT).

When was the last time that you prayed about the problem you're facing? Prayer puts things into perspective.

The next time you're tempted to worry, pray instead. Pray about that problem. Pray about that issue. And ask other people to pray with you.

If you tolerate a Goliath in your life, he will take over your territory. For instance, maybe you think you're going to go ahead and play around with a so-called little sin. You tell yourself that you know when to stop, that you won't go too far. Then one day you have a bona fide giant in your life, and you want it to go away.

You don't reason with a giant or yell at a giant. You kill him. That is what David did. The Bible tells us that "as Goliath moved closer to attack, David quickly ran out to meet him" (1 Samuel 17:48 NLT). That's the only way to take on a giant.

And remember, the battle is the Lord's. Sometimes God will allow us to hit rock bottom, where we don't have any human solutions. If you're in this situation, you may think, "This is too difficult. I have tried everything. The only thing I can do now is trust God."

That's good. Then God will show you what He's capable of. When you see God for who He is, you will see your giants for what they are. He is bigger than anyone or anything else.

History of CMA

The original brainstorm for such an organization occurred in 1972 when Herb Shreve and his teenage son purchased their first motorcycles. It was not until 1974 when the need for a new organization began to be realized. Herb attended his first motorcycle rally and saw a massive crowd of motorcyclists who did not know Jesus Christ as their personal Savior. In fact, many had never heard the Gospel message.

The realization of such a great need prompted Herb to share his vision with a couple of Christian friends. Together, they began to pray. Herb became more and more convinced that God wanted a Christian organization dedicated to reaching motorcyclists with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In the spring of 1975, he put action to his prayers. An attorney was contacted, and a non-profit charter was applied for and approved. The waiting was over. The Christian Motorcyclists Association (CMA) was born

started as an effort to provide just one motorcycle to a pastor in Guatemala. Today, CMA has been able to extend the open arms of Christ to millions of people around the world, through the fruits of Run for the Son.

By partnering with ministries with world-reaching potential, we have been able to place the message of hope and salvation in front of millions of people in 194 countries around the world. Since its beginning,

Run for the Son has invested \$88 million to help spread the Good News of salvation through Christ; resulting in 32.2 million salvations. Some pray, some go, and some send; will you help?

From our Road Captain

Are America's Roads Inherently More Dangerous For Motorcyclists?

There's nothing quite like hitting the open road on a motorcycle. The air is energizing and feels new. Getting some fresh air and moving around can enhance your mood. Everything appears closer, including the sounds and the views, and riders feel more connected to the natural world. That is a major perk for riding motorcycles in the United States.

Despite being swift and flexible, motorbikes are also the most vulnerable to traffic accidents and other road hazards and fatalities. According to statistics from the NHTSA, there were about 82,528 motorcyclists injured and 5,579 fatalities in the United States in 2020. Due to the limited or lack of protection between vehicles and motorcycles, motorcyclists often suffer the most injuries when a collision occurs.

However, drivers are not the only ones that pose a threat to motorcyclists. Inadequate road maintenance and defects in road design cause many problems. It is not uncommon for motorcycle attorneys to use the legal system to tackle unsafe road conditions caused by negligence. Motorcyclists are particularly vulnerable to risks such as motorcycle accidents, severe injuries, and even death from open grate bridges, improperly paved roads, crosswinds, debris, and potholes.

Why Are Motorcycle Accidents More Dangerous Than Car Accidents?

Essentially, motorcycles compromise safety for maneuverability. A significantly higher percentage of fatal injuries occur when there is no barrier between the driver and other cars or the road itself. The reality is that the presence of such protective features as airbags and crumple zones in cars is what ultimately saves the lives of their occupants. Motorcyclists are more likely to die per mile driven than car drivers, and five times more likely to be wounded. The absence of comprehensive safety equipment is just one of many reasons that play a role in motorcyclists being injured on the roadways.

Are Highways Still Safer?

Generally speaking, highway speeds are more stable, making riding a safer option. There is usually a steady flow of traffic; there are not any stop signs or red lights. Most highway lanes are broader, allowing the rider more alternatives for where to travel in the lane, and there are no intersections for motorcycles.

Finally, unlike on back roads, you're usually not directly in the path of oncoming vehicles in the opposite lane. When you consider that, it becomes clear why city streets and back roads are more dangerous. Here in Texas, county and rural roads are considerably riskier to travel on than interstates. Some of the most enjoyable locations on a bike are the back roads though, however, it's a nice thought to keep in mind when you're out there.
