**Run for the Son: The Jesus Film Project**

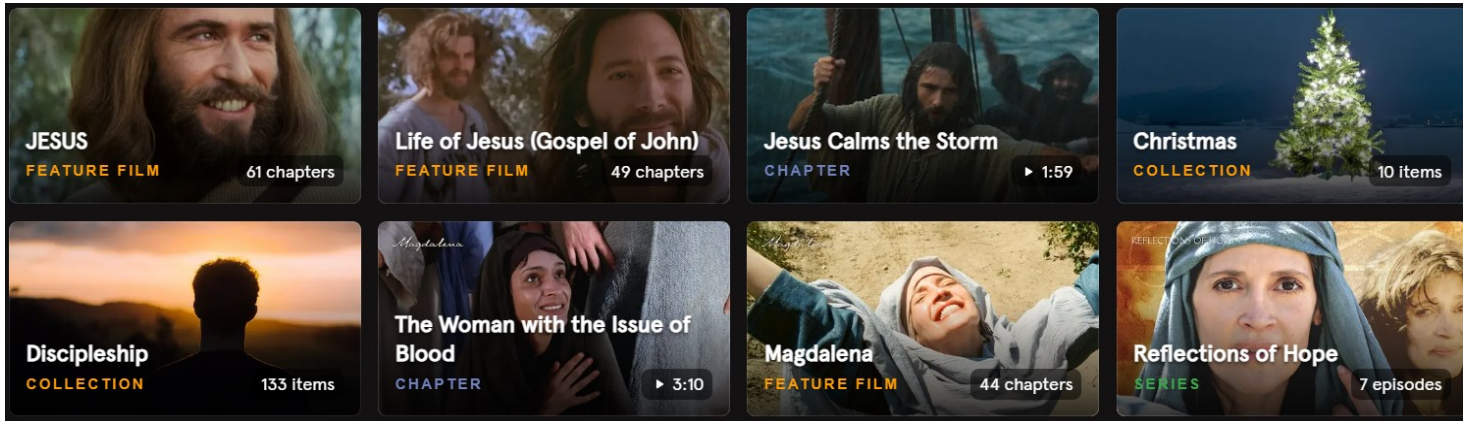

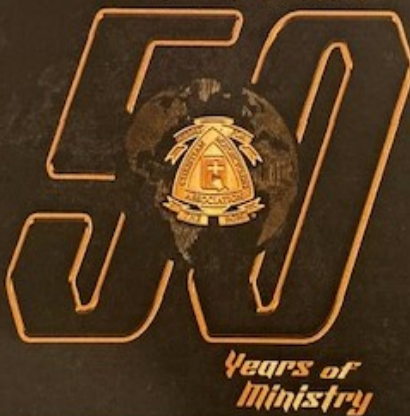
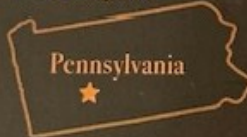
