




















Can Motorcycling Help You Lose Weight? Riding is good for you in many ways. Is weight loss one of them?

Weight loss fads are always changing. Carbs are good. Carbs are bad. Red meat is good. Red meat is bad. Plus you can use statistics to back up any claim you want to make, whether it's true or not. We already know that motorcycling is good for you, but some say that riding can even help you lose weight.

College Professor Rides Cross Country for Mental Health

To say that motorcycling helps you lose weight goes against the stereotypical image of an older male <u>Harley</u> rider with a big gut, where the only six-pack involved is what he drinks when he reaches his destination (<u>hopefully not before</u>). As my own metabolism slows down with age, I've been taking a greater interest in what goes into my body as well as how to burn it effectively. The idea that motorcycling, which has already been my favorite activity for years, could help intrigued me. After watching video I decided to dig a little bit deeper.

Of course, motorcycling websites are quick to point out the beneficial workout and weight loss effects of motorcycling. (Mental health is a given.) A Leather Up blog post discusses it enthusiastically, but ironically it almost contradicts itself at the same time. While saying that a 150-pound person riding a motorcycle for one hour will burn 179 calories, that's barely more than the same person burning 145 calories while driving a car for an hour. It also lists several other forms of exercise that burn far more calories than riding. One important point this post does make, however, is that off-road riding is far more strenuous than simply cruising down the highway. A 230-pound rider can burn 400 calories during an hour of off-road riding, which is even more than bicycling.

Another post at Estonia's <u>Harley-Davidson Tallinn</u> echoes this sentiment, claiming up to 600 calories per hour of off-road riding. Street riders still benefit, though. Turning the handlebars, operating the brakes and clutch, and changing gears are small, simple movements, but they all take a small amount of energy, which adds up during a ride. In contrast, motorcycle passengers get almost no calorie burning benefit, which is all the more reason for passengers to start riding their own ride.

Motorcycle websites are preaching to the choir, so I looked for corroborating evidence from sources that have nothing to do with motorcycles. A discussion on the MyFitnessPal forum includes many riders chiming in on how many calories they burn during their off-road riding. I use the MyFitnessPal app to track my daily calorie intake, and when I looked through its list of possible exercises, I found "Motor-cross" included. At my weight, the app says I would burn 408 calories in one hour of "Motor-cross." My usual road riding is not listed, but activities such as automobile repair, curling, fishing, gardening, horse grooming, and hacky sack all have entries. I suppose that hurling tools and magic car fixing words at an automotive project gone wrong can be a bit of a workout as well. Not that I'd know from experience or anything.

A recent <u>VeryWellFit article</u> cites a 100 calorie per hour estimate for a 150-pound person riding a motorcycle. Most places I look seem to agree that a couch potato (or a RideApart contributor writing this article) burns a mere 68 calories per hour. Even if I'm just commuting to work by motorcycle, I'm doing much better than sitting on the sofa. Taking the long way home on a nice day simply adds to that benefit.

The biggest bang for your buck, though, is off-road riding. You can pick up a used dirt bike or <u>dual sport</u> for cheap, ride it on the street like you normally would, and then hit the dirt for a more intense workout. Add this to my ever increasing list of reasons <u>why I want to add a dual sport</u> to my motorcycle fleet. It's not just fun, but it's good for me, too.



Blessing of the Bikes

Blessing of the Bikes: An opportunity to pray with a motorcyclist for safety during the riding season and any needs that he/she may have.

A blessing of the bikes (or bike blessing) may be performed with one or many motorcyclists as the opportunity arises. When God opens the door, be sensitive and move through the door, understanding that the opportunity is to pray and share Jesus. It is important to remind the motorcyclist that while our riding safety is imperative, it is more important that our lives be in right relationship with Jesus.

The blessing of the bikes card is a tool that can either be read during the time of prayer or given to the individual or group to be read after the time of prayer. Remember that it is not the words you say, but what the Spirit of God does. This is not a complicated matter, but is simply an open door. As God opens the doors, pray with men and women about the needs of their lives and their safety on the highways.

There are many methods to conduct blessing of the bikes. The method described below is one example that works well in many circumstances:

- · Have the riders stand by their motorcycles.
- · Choose several CMA members to assist you.
- · Have each CMA member take cards and stickers and pray as a group.
- Pass out the cards and the stickers to the individual motorcyclists (allowing the motorcyclists to put the stickers on their motorcycles).
- Remind the motorcyclists as you are praying over them and their motorcycles that if they
 have any particular needs this would be a good time for them to present their needs to
 God as you pray.
- Pray a prayer of safety, blessing, and direction from the Spirit of God on the motorcyclists' lives.
- Let the motorcyclists know that if they would like individual prayer after the prayer, they
 can contact you. This would be a good time to pass out Bibles, as you feel led.

Chapter Purpose

Chapters are the lifeblood of CMA. They are made up of CMA members uniting for a common purpose of spreading the light of Christ. Chapters realize that their true strength comes in working together. It is through the network of chapters that we are able to work events to build relationships that lead to opportunities to tell people about Christ. If you want to see God in action, being a part of a CMA chapter is a good place to be.

Chapters recognize that they are part of something bigger than they are and make an effort to support the overall vision of the ministry. Strong, vibrant chapters are critical if we are going to fulfill the mission God has given us. If our chapters suffer, the ministry suffers. A good chapter is a balanced chapter, including each of these four elements in its scope:

- Prayer: sincerely seeking God and lifting up prayer needs (Matthew 18:19; 21:22; Acts 1:14; 1 Timothy 2:8)
- Fellowship: spending time together having fun, visiting, and serving (1 Thessalonians 5:11-17; Hebrews 3:13)
- Discipleship: mentoring and growing people (Matthew 28:19; 2 Timothy 2:2)
- Evangelism: going out and looking for ministry opportunities (Matthew 28:19)

Biker's Sunday

Biker's Sunday: A church service where motorcyclists are invited to attend.

Three common purposes of a Biker's Sunday are:

- · Show support to the local church
- · Provide a setting where motorcycling friends can be invited to church
- Promote Run for the Son

Paul Stege Ministries - Year End Review and Prayer for 2025

Greetings everyone! All praise, honor and glory belong to Jesus our King! He is faithful, just and true. The universe is as drop of water in palm of His Mighty Hand. How He integrates everything and weaves His Spirit upon every human is beyond what I could ever comprehend!

As led by the Holy Spirit our mission has been and still is to:

- 1. Teach and encourage brothers and sisters in Christ to share the Gospel led by the Holy Spirit.
- 2. Distribute His Word as the Lord leads ambassadors to us to share the Gospel and immediately give the Word of God to each person for grow fully in His Ways.
- 3. We believe in the imminent return of Jesus. When He takes us away His Word will be on the ground. Each copy will be precious to those who remain (and they will have stickers in them).

I think it is necessary to update on what your prayers, labor and generosity have been given to and what it has produced.

2024 began with specific instructions on the number of Bibles the Holy Spirit wanted. This is what I strongly believed and acted upon. When I heard 250,000 Bibles I was currently in Genesis reading about Joseph in Egypt. God's Word emphasized to me, like in Joseph's dream about famine coming, he had to plan. For me the same was true. The amount of Bibles He wanted would require planning for the whole year beginning with purchasing stickers. This would require ordering over a million stickers. So we did. This also would require communicating with many churches across the U.S. to accomplish this. So we did. Great favor was given by God and to His Praise 251,260 Bibles were distributed and in His field! All with stickers adhered. And just as important ambassadors sharing the message of the Gospel! His field would include United States major cities, prisons, crisis pregnancy centers, rehabilitation centers for both drug and PTSD, police and fire academies, military, retired military, all of Central America, much of South America, all of Mexico, parts of Africa, Asia and so much more that I could not even begin to expand upon or explain. All of these the Holy Spirit brought to us. We have never looked to distribute, we just obey the Holy Spirit! The exciting thing to think about is if just 1% of the total Bibles distributed received Jesus as Savior that would be over 2,500 people. I do believe it's way more simply because the Lord directed these laborers to get Bibles and give the Gospel with them! The living God is the greatest evangelist ever!

I want to thank Magnolia Bible Church, Fleetwood Bible, One Luv Outreach, Calvary Residential Discipleship, Honey Brook Calvary Chapel, Chester Springs Calvary Chapel, Bangor Calvary Chapel, CMTS and Calvary Chapel of Philadelphia! All these ministries had numerous sticker parties in 2024. These precious churches have labored so hard to make this possible. These beautiful saints in these churches and their willingness and love afforded to me is way beyond what I will ever deserve. For the first time in this ministry more Bibles were processed outside of the state of Texas! May Jesus pour His richest blessings upon you all!

All of this was moved by now 2 trucking companies who want the blessings of Jesus instead of the money for the freight in this life. I am truly indebted and greatly humbled. I do my best to do everything right but I am so far from perfect. They not only afford me grace, but jump in to help me when my paperwork is not fully accurate.

We would also like to thank "The Rock Ministry" in Kensington, Pennsylvania. By His leading we were able to give an imprinter to personalize each Bible given away in this drug torn area. We are also providing the Bible's necessary for this. Thank you Jeff Howe, Craig and Sharon Cerrito, Kevin and Jess Fluharty for implementing this beautiful tool to advance the Gospel.

Thank you Pastor Mark Abrams from Word of Life Calvary Chapel for your heart to organize inner city pastors in Philadelphia to hit the streets with the Gospel and His Word. Over 50,000 copies have hit the streets of inner city Philadelphia in the last 2 years.

Thank you Dora Sustaita who tirelessly takes the Bible's we give (42,000 plus in 2024) and ships them to every country in Central America to some 302 pastors sharing the Gospel and His Word to unreached people groups in these countries.

I literally could go on and on but time is never something I have an abundance of. I continue to work full time plus overtime at my job. We would rather labor led by a King and let Him get all the glory .

Our total Bibles given away now with ambassadors sharing the Gospel is now 1,232,734....That's right. Almost 1 and a quarter million Bibles! I love God's Word and my deepest desire is to see everyone saved and to have a copy of God's Word in their hands so they can grow by the His Word applied in their own life. That daily they would be drawn to His Word, led and taught by the Spirit and empowered to do His Will through their lives.

Psalm 37:4

[4] Delight thyself also in the Lord; and he shall give thee the desires of thine heart.

It is truly a privilege to do anything in His Will. We have and will continue to give it our very best to do everything unto Jesus being led by His Spirit.

Philippians 4:19

[19] But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Our confidence is in Jesus as He continually blows our mind. Each month is an adventure in how He provides. I personally don't like the unknown but what I have learned is trust is a door you walk through opened by Jesus. The other side of the door is fullness of life and a deepening of knowing who He is and more importantly how very weak I am.

One of our greatest desires is to have fruit abounding in your heavenly and earthly accounts. We take great measures to ensure that your time and generosity given are not wasted......

Philippians 4:17

[17] Not because I desire a gift: but I desire fruit that may abound to your account.

This is why we labor without price and maintain this all volunteer commitment on your behalf. We prepare for our events so that there is no waste of time or money. It is all going to equipping of the saints and the growth of the new believers. We still have never asked for a penny, no website or fundraising as this obscure in the dark ministry moves on. We are always a few weeks away from not doing this. Each bill now is so much.

What's in the future?

With the addition of some churches able now to do sticker parties we could comfortably do 280,000 Bibles and have instant homes for all. Is this in God's will? This is what I covet your prayers for. It seems like it would be but I want to always be mindful of dependence on the Holy Spirit moment by moment, day by day.

Another issue the Lord wants me to address is readability. The paperback copies we distribute are either a 7 or 8 font. This can present a big problem for vision challenged people. We have begun the process of purchasing 3x reading magnifiers. These are credit card size magnifiers that can be held to the readers position to see. It's perfect, but this will allow all people to read His Word and the missionary can hold 50 easily in their pockets. I feel strongly the Lord is guiding us to purchase 20,000 of these. Because of time constraints on my part and not having a paid staff the easiest method of purchasing is Amazon at about 17 cents per magnifier.

We have our sticker parties planned for Texas and we are beginning to fill our calendar for out of state events. I have a couple of immediate speaking opportunities I covet your prayers for and a few evangelism training opportunities coming up.

A more than special thanks to my beautiful wife who continues to help in every way. She is the backbone of so much that is not celebrated. I am so very grateful!

So many precious saints help locally and abroad, all led by Jesus to do so. I am so very grateful. To list them would be impossible for me to do without forgetting someone. I would feel so bad. But this I know, God never forgets! He is Perfect!

Hebrews 6:10

[10] For God is not unrighteous to forget your work and labour of love, which ye have shewed toward his name, in that ye have ministered to the saints, and do minister.


Pray that my faith would not fail and I would quickly obey the Holy Spirit to bring glory to His wonderful name!



CMA vest standards

The CMA standard for vests states that:

• The front of a CMA member's vest is to include the CMA USA country patch on the upper left side of the vest (which places the stars closest to the heart and identifies the member's nation) and the 3" CMA logo or CMA name tag with logo on the upper right side of the vest. Nothing is to be placed above the country patch or the 3" CMA patch/name tag. Patches or pins that take you out of a neutral ministering position may not be worn on a vest with the CMA back patch or logo.

• The back of a CMA member's vest is to include

• The back of a CMA member's vest is to include the CMA back patch and be easily distinguishable that the person is a CMA member. No other patches or rockers should be placed on the back of a CMA vest (i.e. territorial rockers indicating a city, state, chapter, or other location).
