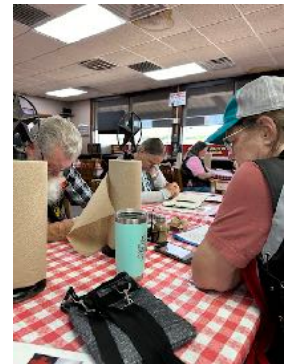
## Marilyn's Minutes

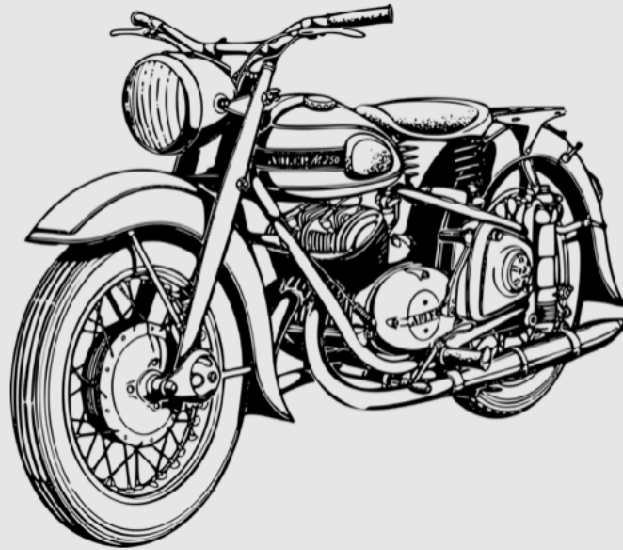

# MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST



## Reminder Before Riding

Always check the following

1. Tire pressure
2. Oil levels when engine is hot
3. Lights
4. Battery terminals
5. Nut & bolts are tight
6. Brake pads
7. Air filter
8. Tire wear
9. Inspection sticker
10. Any leaks
11. Chain or belt tension
12. Wheel spokes loose or tight

Remember always check your tire pressure bolts and nuts oil level when engine is hot and battery terminals

“But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us” (2 Corinthians 4:7, NKJV).
